



Foxborough Public Safety Facility Foxborough, MA

Client: Town of Foxborough

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The project site is located on a portion of the 150 acre former Foxborough State Hospital campus in Foxborough, MA. The site is located at the intersection of North Street, Payson Road, Chestnut Street and close to Main Street (Route 140). The 39,000 s.f. Public Safety Facility houses the full operations of the Town's Police and Fire Departments and the Town's Emergency Management Center.

BCG prepared the base mapping for the project area, to include underground utility location and topographic mapping of the site. It also provided civil engineering services. The scope included designing the following utilities: drainage, electric/fiber optic, gas, domestic and fire protection water, and sewer. The project underwent a major rebid when the initial bids were over the estimated budget. Most of the savings came from the redesign of the drainage system that allowed the Town to continue to protect public safety while at the same time using a design that was sensitive to the budgetary impacts.

BCG provided construction surveying services and also provided construction overview for the construction of the utilities.

The project was completed in 2007.
